Alberta Cricket Association Player Selection Policy

- 1.1: Role of Provincial Selectors: The principal role of the Selection Committees is to select teams to represent Alberta that will:
 - Maximize Alberta's chances of winning each game or series; and
 - Guarantee the long-term success of Cricket in Alberta.
- 1.2: Alberta Cricket Association will establish selection committee for the Men's and Women's programs.
- 1.3: Appointment of Provincial Selectors: President with Consultation with Board of Directors is responsible for the appointment of selectors.
- 1.3.1: The composition of the Selection Committee shall be consisting of three Selectors:
 - Minimum One Selector from Calgary
 - Minimum One Selector from Edmonton
- 1.3.2 : Selection committee members are appointed for two years.
- 2.1: Selection: The Selection Committees are responsible for selecting the following squads to represent Alberta in Provincial and National competitions and in any other competition if requested by the Board of Directors:
 - Senior Men and Women
 - U19
 - U17
 - Alberta High Performance

The selection committees also recommend players for consideration for development programs

2.2: Selection Events/Camps/schedule

 Selectors shall provide and seek Board approval for a selection program/schedule for Current year prior to April 30th.

2.3: Communication

- Each selector shall report to the committee with performance evaluations on each player under consideration in their region from the games attended.
- Player performance from each tour or tournament shall be discussed by the selection committee after completion of tour/event/tournament.
- Agreements on availability and compensation shall be obtained from the players prior to making final selections.

3.1: The selectors will consider the following when selecting players for Provincial squads/teams:

- Performances (past and present) be it in club competition, Intercity and Provincial championships.
- Commitment as shown through participation in trials, Provincial and National initiatives, events and selection camps; participation in leagues and tournaments;
- Attitude demonstrating a strong work ethic, desire to improve and bea team player;
- Physical fitness;
- Acceptance of the tour participation agreement;
- All players selected must meet the Cricket Canada eligibility criteria for National and Provincial events;
- Contribution to the team environment, including general attitude and behavior.

3.2: Players must be in good standing with club, league, province and Cricket Canada
